**Project Description**

The existing water tower at Owen Ln. is almost 50 years old and is in need of replacement. This project includes demolition of the old tower and replacement with a new, composite tower.

**Project History**

The current Owen Ln. Water Tower was built almost 50 years ago. At the time it was built, it was a main storage supply and pressure component for west Waco. With the addition of towers on Schroeder Dr. and Richie Rd., water storage for west Waco has increased substantially over the years, but the Owen Ln. tower remains a critical component of the water system and must be replaced due to its condition.

**Community Benefit**

This project ensures safe operation and reliable water service, maintaining water quality standards and providing adequate storage supply for customers in the western portion of Waco.
